Four elementary schools in the Puget Sound area will win. The contest begins in November 2010 and ends on January 24, 2011.

TO ENTER

To enter, go online to potatokids.com, GreenhouseMegastore.com, Star1015.com, or komonews.com, click on the "Kids Are Growing" button linking to the "Kids Are Growing" contest page at potatokids.com, print the entry form, and follow instructions as stated on the form and in the rules.

ONLY ONE SUBMISSION PER SCHOOL PLEASE, whether it is an individual, classroom or school project.

ELIGIBILITY

No purchase necessary to enter and win. The contest is open to parents, teachers and school administrators of elementary schools (kindergarten through 6th grade) in the King, Snohomish, Pierce, Thurston, Kitsap and Mason county school districts, who are legal residents of Washington, 21 years of age or older. Verification of an entrant's eligibility may be required.

SUBMISSIONS

Entry submissions should tell us **what winning the greenhouse would do for your school and what the students would do and learn** from the new resource. Entrants should also **create and submit an original healthy potato recipe**. All materials submitted become the property of the sponsors for use in publications and promotions.

Submissions must be in a three-ring notebook and contain the completed entry form signed by the school principal or vice principal, acknowledging the validity of the application and willingness to accept the award if selected. Submissions may contain letters, essays, drawings, photos or other media, as long as it can be contained in a three-ring binder with the completed entry form.

Submissions will be judged on the basis of originality, creativity and educational value of the prize to the students.

Completed submissions must be mailed to the Washington State Potato Commission, 108 Interlake Road, Moses Lake WA 98837. All entries must be postmarked by January 24, 2011. No mechanically reproduced entries will be accepted. From all entries received, four winners will be selected by a panel of judges from participating sponsors. Winners will be notified by the week of February 21, 2011. If a winner is unreachable after two business days, an alternate winner will be selected by contest judges from the remaining qualified entries. Odds of winning shall be determined by number of eligible entries received. Prize packages are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash value.

PRIZES

Each prize is for the entrant's elementary school and consists of:

- One (1) EasyGrow greenhouse kit (assembly required by winner) from GreenhouseMegastore.com. Greenhouse measures approximately 6 feet wide x 8 feet long after assembly. Approximate retail value of each greenhouse is: \$895 U.S.
- One (1) \$1,000 grant from the Washington State Potato Commission.
